

Install WIN2000

The LAN Device Driver can't be set up automatically, you need double click on **My Computer** -> **Control Pnael** -> **System** icon to bring up **System Properties** screen.


Select tab "**Hardware**" and then "**Device Manager**" bar.



The **Device Manager** windows will appear on your screen.

You will find a yellow "?" mark on **Etherent Controller**, that means the driver is not recognized.

Double click on the **Etherent Controller**.



Then **Ethernet Controller Properties** windows will appear on your screen.

Click on the "**Reinstall Driver**" bar to install driver.




The **Upgrade Device Driver Wizard** windows will appear on your screen. Click on **"Next"** bar to continue.



Please choose **"Display a list of the known drivers for this device so that I can choose a specific driver"** to the manual install driver, and click on **"Next"** bar to continue.



Select **"Network adapter"** bar for LAN device and click on **"Next"** bar to continue.



Insert the support CD by the mainboard manufacturer and choose **"Have Disk"** bar to continue next step.



Indicate the driver's location as
"D:\lan\WIN2000\NETRTS5.INF" (In this location CD disk drive is supposed to be "D" letter.)




Select "Realtek RTL8139 [A/B/C/8130] PCI Fast Ethernet NIC" to install, and then click on "Next".



Make sure "Realtek RTL8139 [A/B/C/8130] PCI Fast Ethernet NIC" driver, and click on "Next".

Then the system will do the setup automatically.



Completing the upgrade device driver, and click on "Finish" to restart the system to take all the changes effect.



After restart, you may check Network adapters under the location mentioned at right figure.
