1. First time to setup Media Center

- (1) Press the Media Center Start button  on the remote control or Keyboard. You will see the Media Center setup wizard.
- (2) Press **Next**.



- (1) You should complete 2 sections, **Required Setup** or **Optional Setup**.
- (2) Press **Next**.



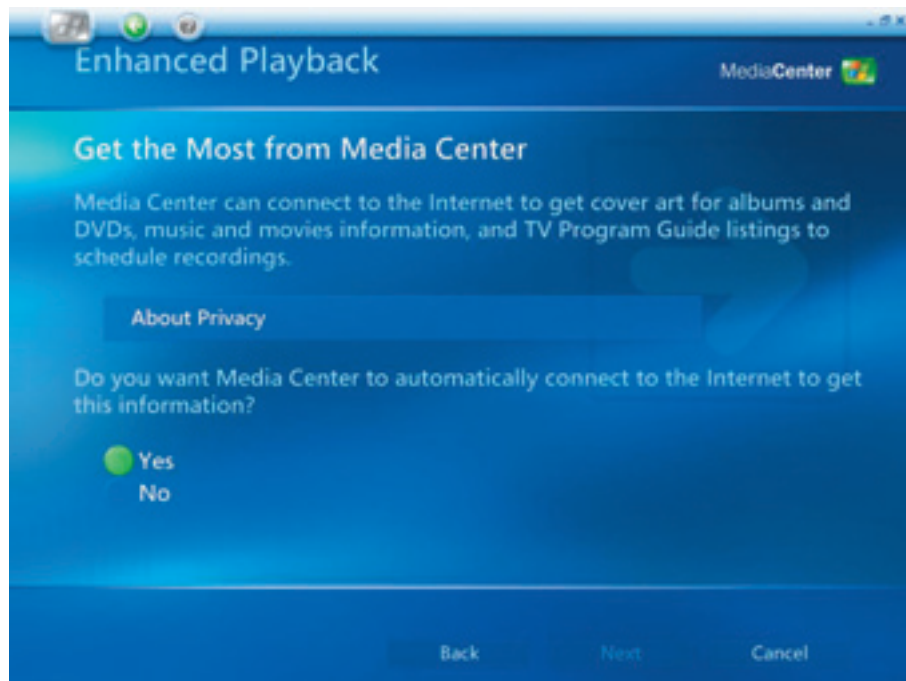

- (1) Shuttle Media Center has bundled a **802.11g Wireless Lan**. Choose **"Yes"** to join **Wireless Network Wizard**.

- (1) Select your wireless network.
- (2) Press **Next**.



- (1) You have configured your wireless network.
- (2) Select **Finish** to exit.



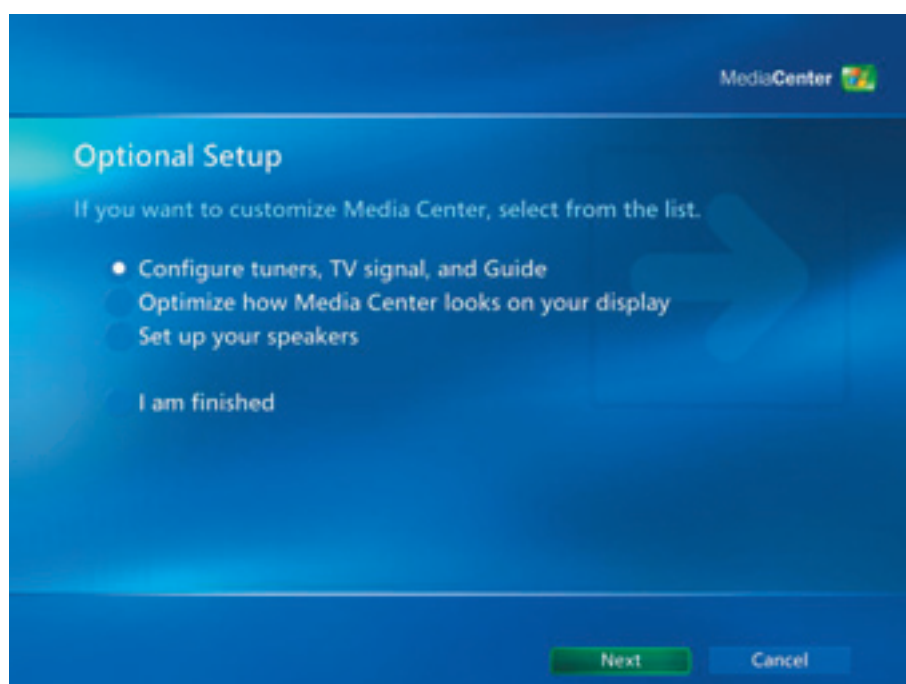
- (1) If you have an **"Always on"** internet connection, please choose **"Yes"** .
- (2) Press **Next**.



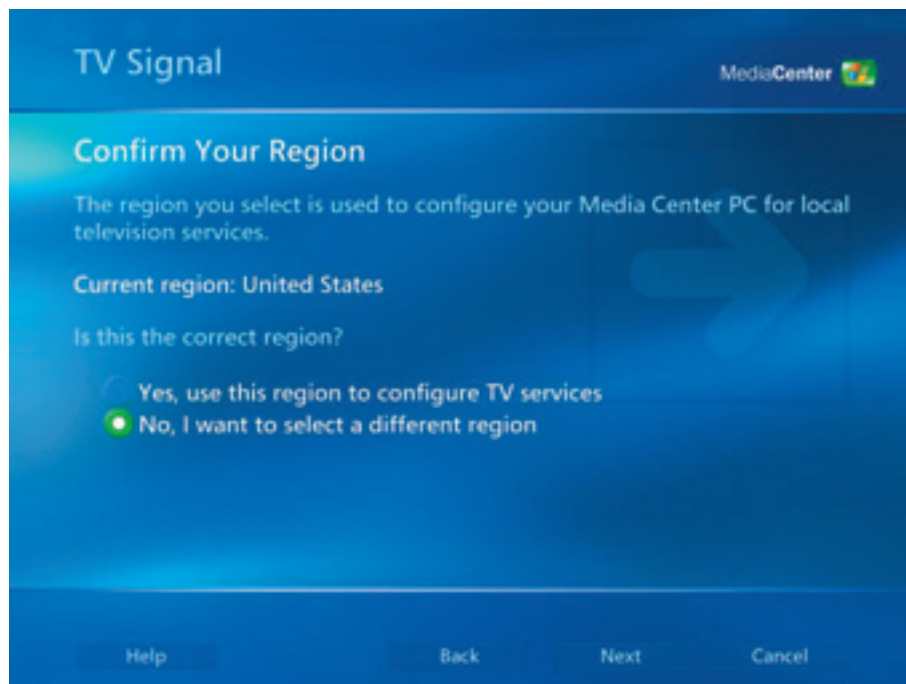
- (1) Select **"Test"** to make sure your internet connection is all right.

(2) Press **Next**.

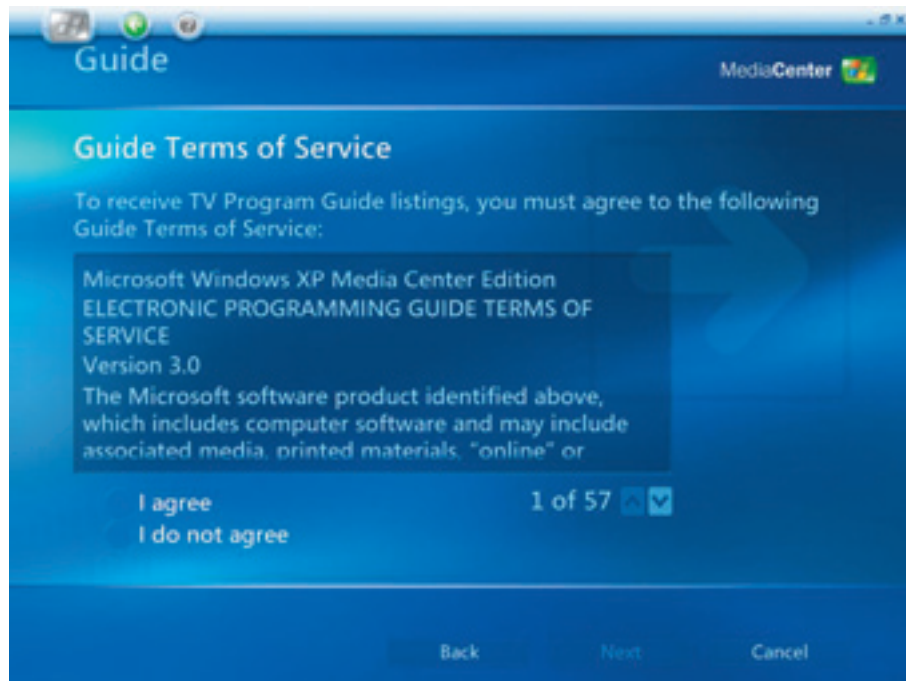


(1) Select **"Yes"** if you want to have a TV program guide.

(2) Press **Next**.



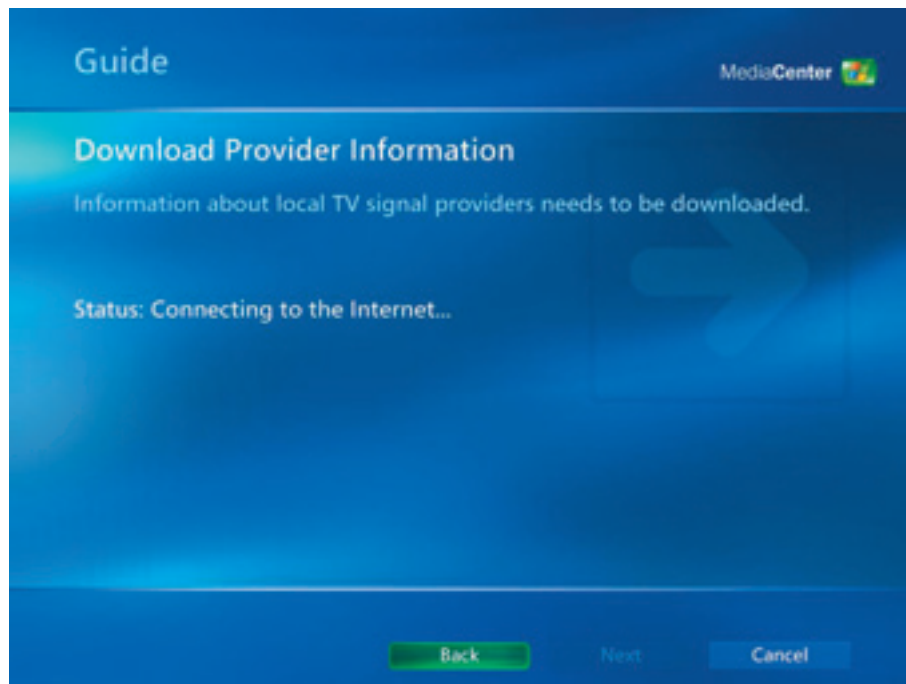
- (1) Please read the TV program guide terms of service and select **"I agree"**.

 - (2) Press **Next**.



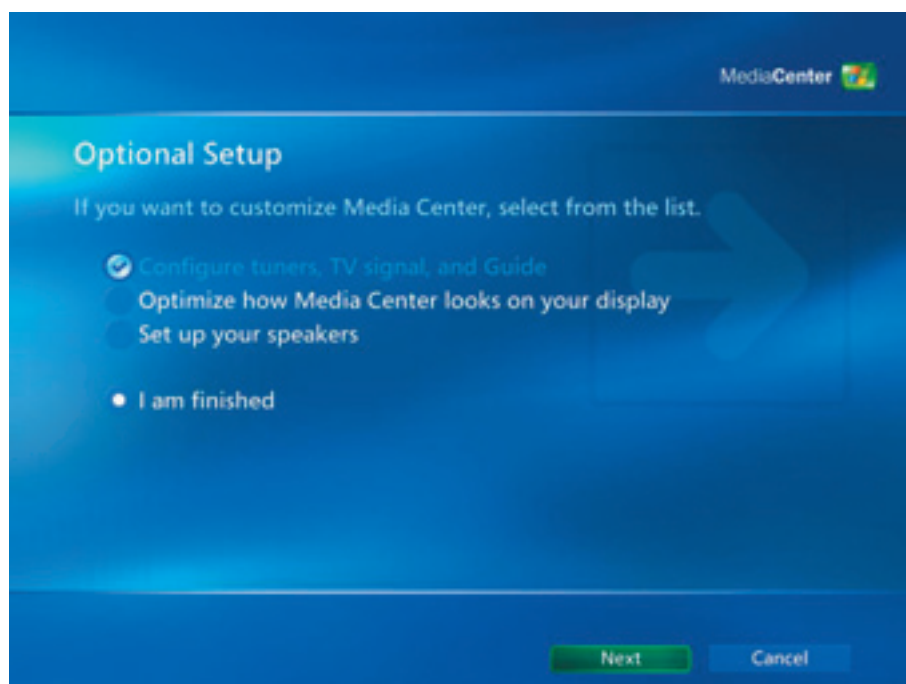
- (1) Please select the TV signal provider.
- (2) Press **Next**.



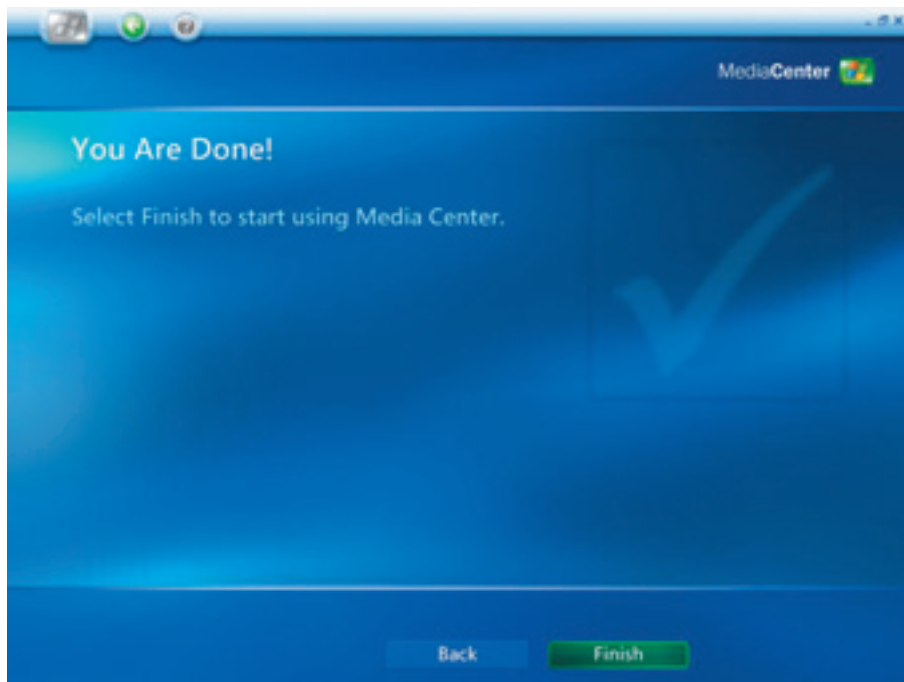

2. Watching and Recording TV Programs

■ Watching TV

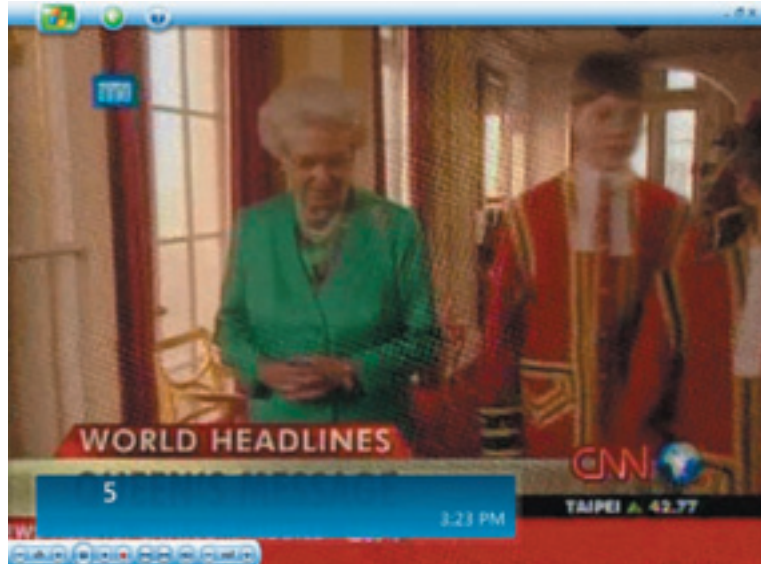
(1) You can watch TV show by selecting **"My TV"**.




(2) Please select **"Live TV"** to watch TV shows.



- (3) User can select a channel by using the **CH/PG (+),(-)** buttons or the numeric keypad on the remote control. The channel number and program information are displayed on the screen.



- (4) Press , the more information button to open another menu with the following options and information:
- A zoom option.
 - Access to Messenger and Settings windows.
 - Program information such as channel number station, title, time period of program, actual time, and a brief summary of the program and TV rating, if they are available. Otherwise, recording options are also shown.



■ Recording TV

(1) Please select **"Recorded TV"** to record TV show.



(2) Please select **"Guide"** to get more information of the TV show.



- (3) You can get the information of each TV channel by using the **"Guide"** function.



3. Playing Music Files

(1) Select **"My Music"**.

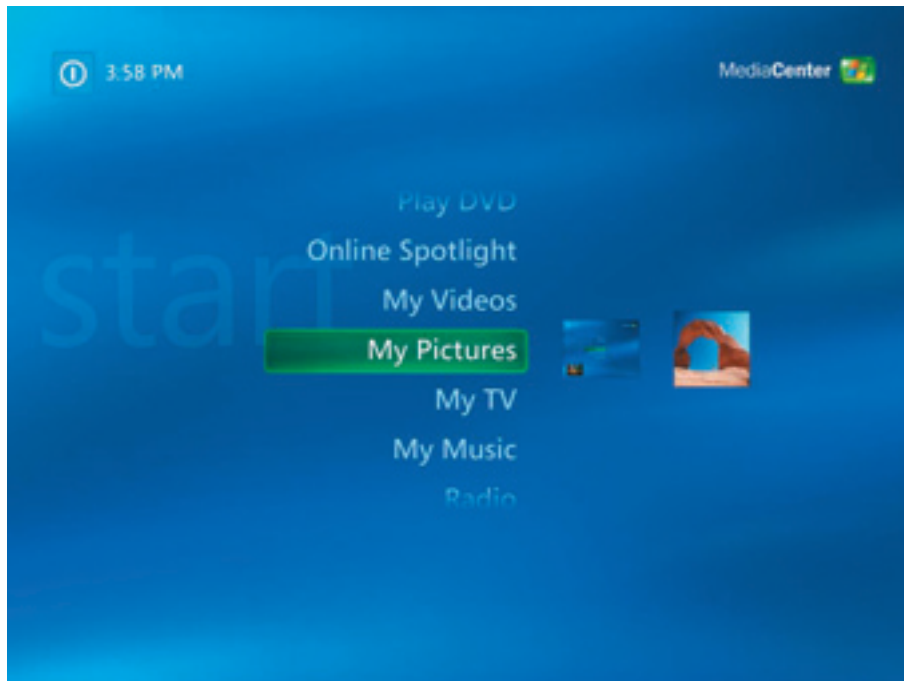


(2) You can play a song or get information by selecting these alternative items.

(2) You can browse pictures by using different way and create CD/DVD by yourself.

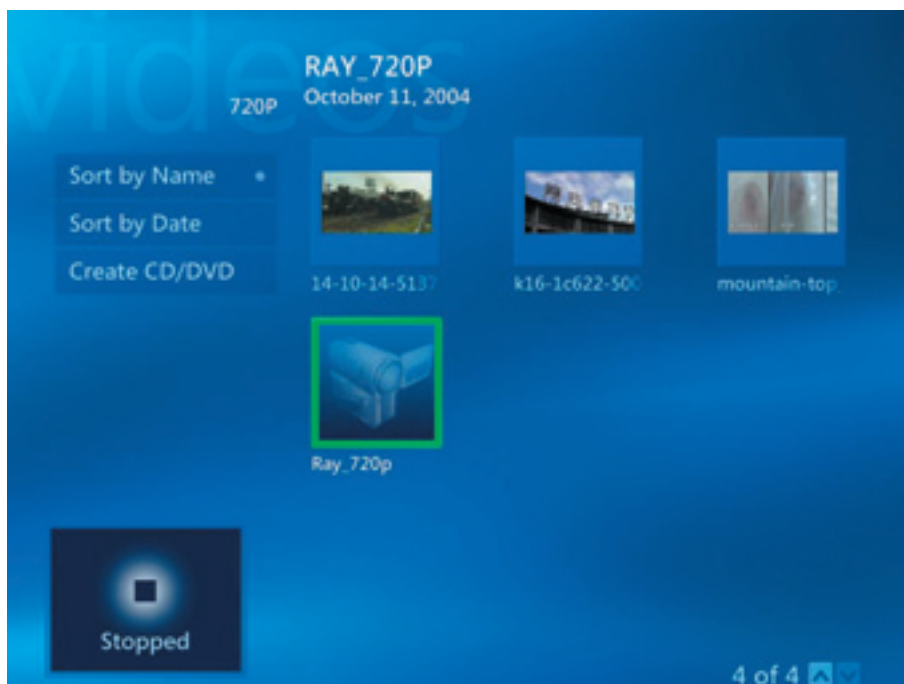


5. Playing Videos

(2) You can watch videos and create CD/DVD by yourself.



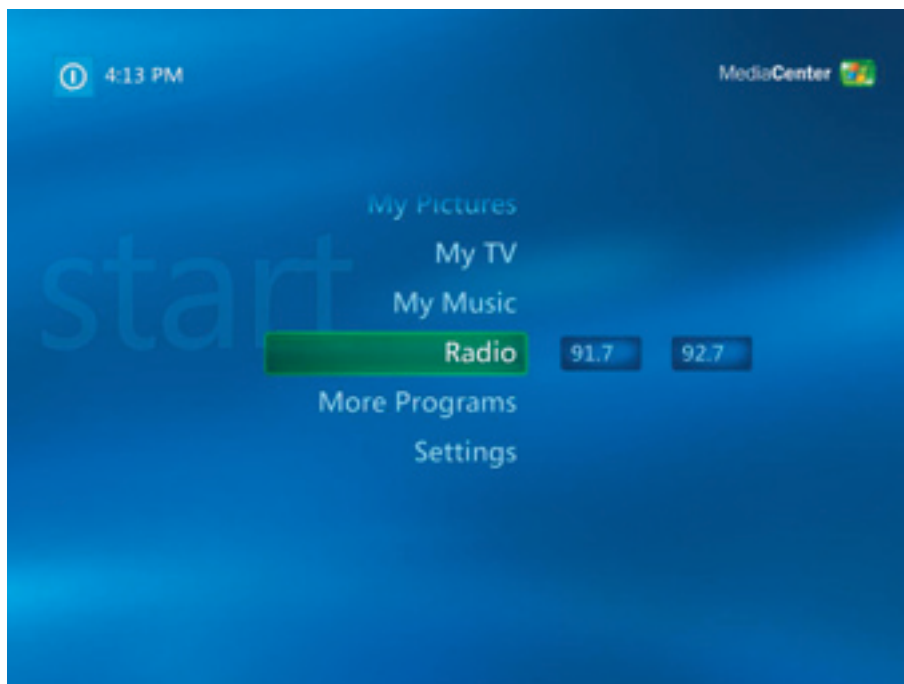
6. Playing DVDs
